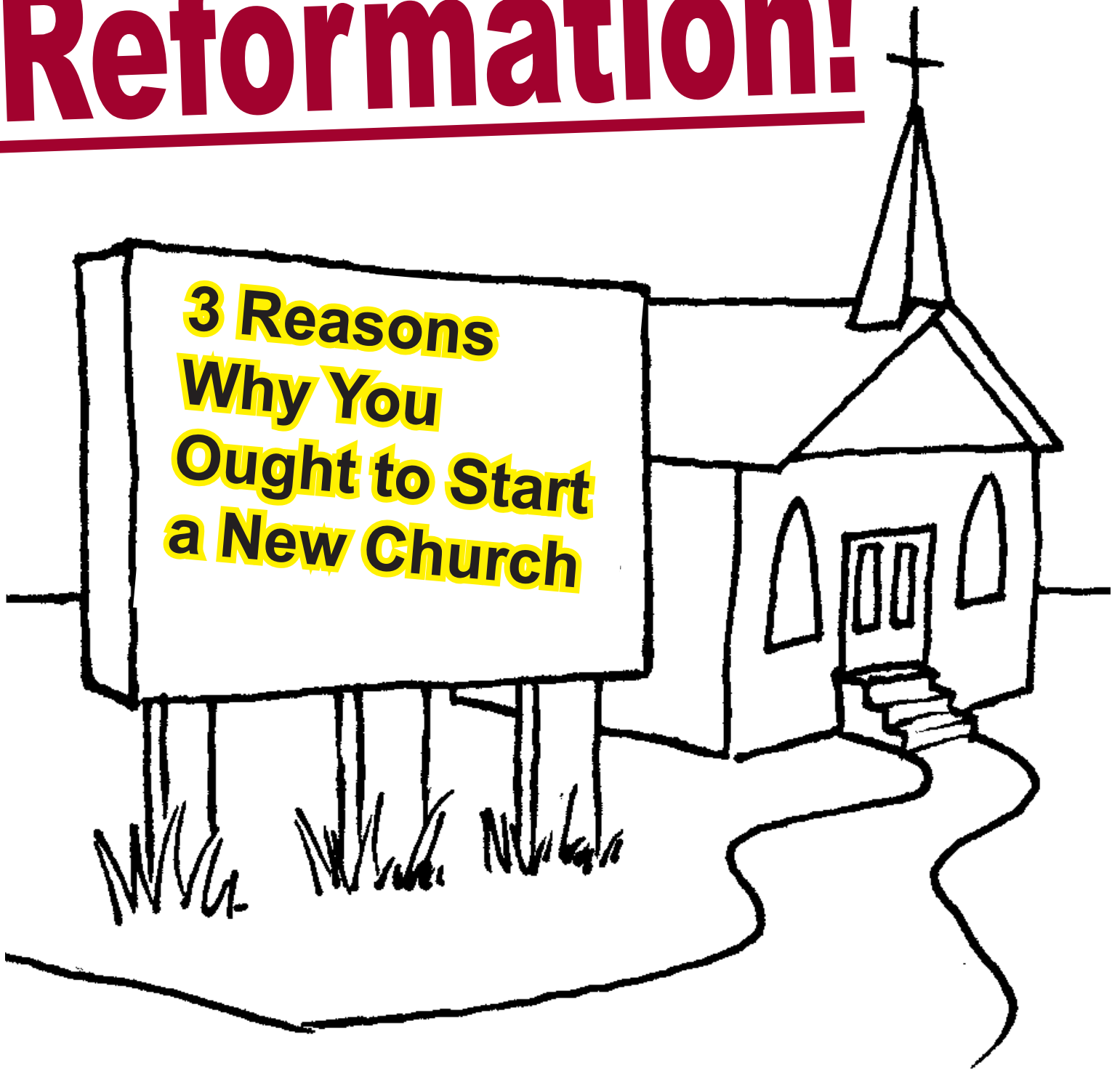

# Reason #1 -- Because Churches Are Not Teaching the True Response to the Gospel [i.e. the DBR 1 Cor 15:1-5]

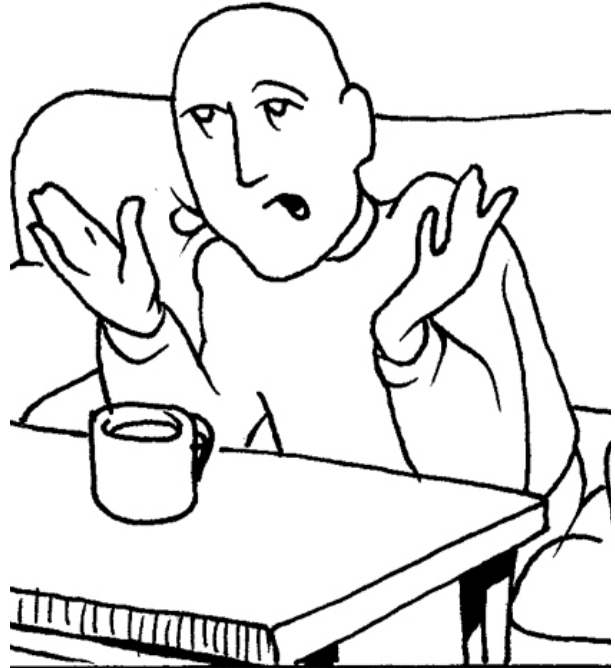

# WARNING ! ! !

Beware! Do you understand the danger that you face, the risk that you take, and the consequences when you continue to be a member of a church that does not teach the true response to the gospel for salvation, does not practice true worship, or is not led by true leaders? Your church will not be considered obedient to the gospel, and therefore will have to pay the penalty (2 Thess 1:8, 9). Your church will not be sought out by the Father in its worship of Him (Jn 4:23). Your church leaders will be considered unqualified, uncalled, and unequipped to minister the gospel to you, or even worse they will be considered false teachers (2 Pe 2:1).

## Do You Understand What You Are Being Called to Do?

### You're Being Called to Be A Pioneer vs. a Settler

What's the difference between a pioneer and a settler? A pioneer blazes the trail for others to walk in. He takes the risk. He suffers the hardship & the strain. He incurs the initial expenses. He's lonely. He may even die trying [Christ did]. Etc. But in the manner in which he is successful, he's a memorable and honorable hero to settlers and to the one who sent him on the journey. Americans would think of Christopher Columbus, or the first man on the moon, etc. Now Settlers wait for the report, and afterward they could be motivated and encouraged to go where the pioneer has gone, in large numbers.

### You're Being Called to Be a Reformer vs. Part of the Problem

Do you understand the difference between being a reformer & part of the problem? What's a reformer? A reformer tries to change himself and others. To reform is to change. To reform is to repent. So a reformer is sort of a repent. What's the opposite of a reformer? It's being part of the problem. You don't try to change yourself or others. You're not a repent. You're not a reformer. Martin Luther understood the difference between being a reformer and part of the problem when he nailed his 95 point differentiating thesis to the door of a Catholic church building. His thesis is said to have sparked the so called Protestant Reformation that you and I now enjoy. But now you need to reform the Christian church based on the evidence that I gave to you today.

### On July 4th, 1776, America's Declaration of Independence Said This:

*“ The Unanimous Declaration of the Thirteen United States of America, When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation. ”*

But now it has become necessary for you to dissolve the church bands that have connected you with others and assume among the churches of the earth the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and of nature's God entitle you. This must be your unanimous declaration based on the three reasons that I gave to you today.

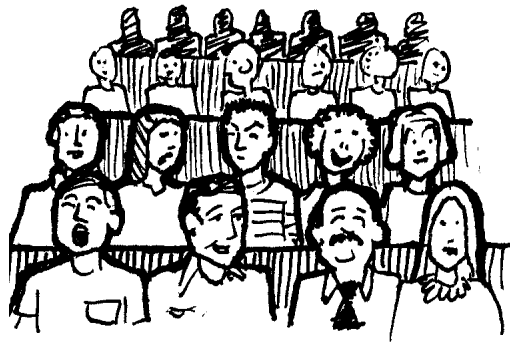
### The Preamble to America's Constitution Says This:

*“ We the people of the United States, in order to form a more perfect union, establish justice, insure domestic tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America. ”*

But now, in order to form a more perfect church, you need to establish one. You need to ordain a church based on the true response to the gospel, the true form of worship, and true ministry. But don't write a church constitution. Just stick with the Bible as your sole constitution, deed, and statement of faith.

## Jesus and the Apostles and Prophets Were Reformers vs. Part of the Problem

God reformed the church through Jesus (He 9:10), the apostles, and prophets [as well as many others in times past, like Moses, Ezra, Nehemiah, Josiah, etc.]. Truly, the gospel is a gospel of reformation. We need to be reformers. A true Christian is a reformer, just like Jesus and His apostles and prophets were reformers. You are being called to be a reformer of the Christian church based on three essential things: [1] the true gospel and the true response to the gospel for salvation, [2] the true worship format, & [3] true leadership, ministry, & callings. **Are you willing to answer the call to pioneer, regroup, and reform the Christian church?**



## DO NOT BE ASHAMED OF IT

“ For I am not ashamed of the gospel [i.e. the DBR], for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone. ” (Ro 1:16)

Likewise, you ought to say,

#1 “ I am not ashamed of the true response to the gospel, for it is how God [and his apostles and prophets] initially considered a person faithful toward Him. ”

[eg. Paul considered Lydia **faithful** to the Lord when she obeyed the true response / Acts 16:13-15]

#2 “ I am not ashamed of the true worship format, for it is what the Father is seeking. ”

[Jesus said it Himself / Jn 4:23]

#3 “ I am not ashamed of true leadership and true ministry, for it is the proper and fitting way to cause growth. ” [The proper working of each individual church member causes growth / Eph 4:16]
